# REGISTRATION RULES

THE FS EAST EVENT INTENDS TO ORGANISE A SIMPLE, AND CLEAR REGISTRATION PROCEDURE, KEEPING IN MIND, THAT OVERSEAS TEAMS MAY HAVE DISADVANTAGE CAUSED BY INTERNET LATENCIES.

## 1. TEAM REGISTRATION

Team Registration opens 26th of January 2016 22:00 CET.

The Team Registration Form will be available at: <http://fseast.eu/registration>

### IMPORTANT:

Every registered team will get a **unique identification number** at the Team Registration, which will be used for identification at the Event Registration Quiz.

### NOTE:

After the Team Registration you will get a confirmation email with your data.

## 2. EVENT REGISTRATION QUIZ FORMS (IC AND EV)

**The Event Registration Order will be determined by the results of the Event Registration Quiz.**

Event Registration Quiz opens 2nd of February 2016 12:00 CET.

Separate Event Registration Quiz Forms will be available for Internal Combustion (IC) and Electric Vehicle (EV) Teams.

### THE FOLLOWING TEAM DATA WILL BE REQUIRED

- Team name
- **Unique identification number**, which was received at the Team Registration
- Answers of single choice and/or multiple choice questions

### IMPORTANT:

After you finished, you must click the "Submit" button at the end of the Event Registration Quiz Form.

**The system will log the timestamp, which will be used to create the registration order.**

Every wrong answer will add 60 seconds to the registration timestamp.

Each team will have only one opportunity. (The first submitted form will be used at the evaluation.)

### NOTE:

After the Event Registration you will get a confirmation message: "Your response has been recorded."

B

DEFINITION OF REGION B:

Countries in standard time zones from -1 to -12 (international date line).

C

DEFINITION OF REGION C:

Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Georgia, Greece, Hungary, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Lithuania, Moldova, Montenegro, Poland, Romania, Russia, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Turkey, Ukraine

D

DEFINITION OF REGION D:

Countries in standard time zones from 0 to +12 (international date line), except countries of region A and C.

EVENT REGISTRATION PHASE 1:

Event Registration Phase 1 will end 20th of February 2016 23:59:59 CET  
In the Event Registration Phase 1 each region will have a separate waiting list:

Registration Lists of Regions	Name of the corresponding waiting lists:
List A (12 combustion engines, and 6 electric slots)	WA1
List B (2 combustion engines, and 1 electric slots)	WB1
List C (12 combustion engines, and 6 electric slots)	WC1
List D (2 combustion engines, and 1 electric slots)	WD1

During the 1st phase every region's slot will be filled only from their own waiting list.

EVENT REGISTRATION PHASE 2:

Event Registration Phase 2 will start 21st of February 2016 00:00 CET.  
The teams who have already registered can not register again.  
A separate waiting list will be opened for newly registered teams, named WABCD2:

Region	Name of the new waiting list:
A, B, C, and D (28 combustion engined, and 14 electric slots)	WABCD2

**Order of prioritising for region A open slots (highest to lowest):**  
WA1, WB1, WD1, WC1, WABCD2

**Order of prioritising for region B open slots:**  
WB1, WA1, WD1, WC1, WABCD2

**Order of prioritising for region C open slots:**  
WC1, WD1, WB1, WA1, WABCD2

**Order of prioritising for region D open slots:**  
WD1, WC1, WB1, WA1, WABCD2

4. FILLING THE FREE PLACES OF A DIFFERENT FUEL TYPE

During the Event Registration Phase 2 from 27th of February 23:59:59 the remained free places of a fuel type will be filled with Waiting List applicants of the other fuel type. If there are any free IC places, they will be filled with EV teams, and vica versa.

## 5. REGISTRATION FEE

Teams will have to pay the 1100 EUR + VAT registration fee (which does not include the lodging fee if a team applies for student hostel beds). There is no limit to team size. The registration fee must be paid within 10 working days after getting a place on the starting list. Registration fees are not refundable for any reason.
